**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FOR A GRANT TO AID IN CONVERSION TO THE NATIONAL INCIDENT BASED REPORTING SYSTEM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT PROGRAM; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division has announced a grant program to aid law enforcement agencies in converting to the National Incident Based Reporting System (the "NIBRS"); and

**WHEREAS**, the NIBRS consists of a uniform methodology for reporting crimes and other similar events in order to develop better national statistics of incidence and management for use by both local and national law enforcement agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the Seguin Police Department is seeking \$38,075.00 for the purchase of infrastructure and software needed for the conversion to NIBRS; and

**WHEREAS**, since the grant does not require a city match, the grant request will be for the entire estimated amount.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby approves the submission of the grant application for the National Incident Based Reporting System Grant to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council hereby designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official who is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**SECTION 3.** The City of Seguin agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds awarded, the City of Seguin assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution is in full force and effect from and after the date of passage.
