Subject: The Installation of a 2,800 GPM Turbine Pump and 300 HP Motor

Date: February 23, 2017

On February 21, 2017, the City of Seguin opened bids for the Surface Water High Service Pump Station Upgrade project, this would consist of the removal of a 1,000 GPM Turbine Pump and 50 HP Motor and the installation of a new 2,800 GPM Turbine Pump and 300 HP Motor. This upgrade would meet any future needs at the Surface Water High Service Pump Station

Note: This upgrade was also made as part of an agreement Between the City of Seguin and Niagara Bottling to ensure all water demands of their operation are fulfilled.

Bids were received from three different contractors ranging from low base bid of \$120,191.29 from Austin Armature Works, LP to the high bid of \$149,393.00 from J & K Utility Services LLC. City staff has reviewed the proposed bids and recommends awarding the contract to Austin Armature Works, the lowest qualified bidder for the Surface Water High Service Pump Station Upgrade, at a base bid of \$120,191.29. Project funding is in the FY 2017 Multi –Year Capital Improvement plan.
