CITY OF SEGUIN

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR CRIME VICTIM SERVICES DIVISION FOR A VICTIM COORDINATOR AND LIAISON GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT PROGRAM; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor Crime Victim Services Division assists in funding a Crime Victims Liaison position that is mandated by State law; and

WHEREAS, as required by the State, the Police Department presently employs a person serving as the Crime Victims Liaison; and

WHEREAS, the grant application which is in the amount of \$84,000.00 covers the salary (minus benefits) beginning September 1, 2017 for a period of two years; and

WHEREAS, the City's match is the cost of the city employee benefits paid to the Crime Victim's Liaison.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the submission of the grant application to the Office of the Governor, Crime Victim Services Division for funding a Crime Victims Liaison.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official who is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 3. The City of Seguin agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds awarded, the City of Seguin assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full

SECTION 4. This Resolution is in full force and effect from and after the date of passage.
