## A RESOLUTION REPLACING THE SEGUIN THOROUGHFARE PLAN AND THE NEW BRAUNFELS – SEGUIN REGIONAL TRANSPORATION PLAN WITH A NEW CITY OF SEGUIN MASTER THOROUGHFARE PLAN

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin desires to support and administer transportation management plans that enhance the quality of life for the citizens of Seguin and the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin desires to support such transportation management plans for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Seguin and the ETJ; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin adopted the Seguin Thoroughfare Plan in conjunction with the Comprehensive Master Plan on October 21, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seguin adopted the New Braunfels – Seguin Regional Transportation Plan on August 16, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has developed a Master Thoroughfare Plan that incorporates and refines roadways and concepts from all previously adopted plans; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force appointed by City Council has considered the Master Thoroughfare Plan and recommended approval as presented herein and as shown on the attached exhibit; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission has considered the Master Thoroughfare Plan and recommended approval as presented herein and as shown on the attached exhibit; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

## SECTION 1

That the City Council of Seguin, Texas replaces the Seguin Thoroughfare Plan and the New Braunfels – Seguin Regional Transportation Plan with the City of Seguin Master Thoroughfare Plan as presented herein and as shown on the attached exhibit.

## SECTION 2

The Seguin Thoroughfare Plan as shown in the Comprehensive Plan shall be considered illustrative only. The City of Seguin Master Thoroughfare Plan as hereby adopted shall function as the City's regulatory Thoroughfare Plan.
