## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR A STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE GRANT FOR FIRE EXTINGUISHER AND SMOKE GENERATOR TRAINING MATERIALS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE GRANT PROGRAM; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS,** the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") has started a grant program for Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response ("SAFER" Grant) to be used to partially support fire departments in their mission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Department would like to submit a grant for the purchase of fire extinguisher and smoke generator training materials; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Department seeks to submit a SAFER grant application in the amount of \$14,271.00 with a cost share of \$679.57.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby approves the submission of the grant application for a SAFER Grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council hereby designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official who is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**SECTION 3.** The City of Seguin agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the FEMA funds awarded, the City of Seguin assures that the funds will be returned to FEMA in full.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution is in full force and effect from and after the date of passage.
