RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS AUTO BURGLARY AND THEFT PREVENTION AUTHORITY; DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS THE AUTHORIZED EXECUTIVE OFFICER FOR THE GRANT PROCESS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Texas Revised Civil Statutes Article 4413(37) and Texas Administrative Code Title 43; Part 3; Chapter 57, entities are eligible to receive grants from the Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority to provide financial support to law enforcement agencies for economic automobile theft enforcement teams and to combat motor vehicle burglary in the jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, this grant program will assist this jurisdiction to combat motor vehicle burglary and theft by providing \$66,529.00, with not match, for the creation of a full time police officer position focused on burglary and theft prevention; and

WHEREAS, City of Seguin Police Department has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the grant funds, City of Seguin Police Department assures that the grant funds will be returned in full to the Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council hereby approves a grant application in the amount of \$66,529.00 to the Texas Auto Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority for the creation of a police officer position focused on burglary and theft prevention.

Part 2. The city manager, Douglas Faseler is designated as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant.

Part 3. Bruce Ure, Deputy Chief of Police, is designated as the Program Director and Susan Caddell, Finance Director, is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.

Part 4. This Resolution is effective from and after the date of its passage.
