A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDED FUQUAY, INC. A BID NOT TO EXCEED \$375,000.00 THROUGH THE BUYBOARD PURCHASING COOPERATIVE FOR A CURED IN PLACE PIPE AND PIPELINE REHABILITATION PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, six inch diameter vitrified clay pipe currently serves as the sewer service mains in three specified residential areas; and

WHEREAS, approximately 2,225 linear feet of this sewer service is in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, site-specific restraints dictate that the pipe is best replaced through pipe bursting, rather than open cut trenching; and

WHEREAS, the pipe bursting process will allow for a size increase in pipe diameter from six inch to eight inches; and

WHEREAS, the project will also include street restoration partially performed by City crews; and

WHEREAS, Fuquay, Inc.'s BuyBoard Contract is in the amount of \$349,466.00; and

WHEREAS, staff requests an additional \$25,544.00 to pay for needed structural improvements to the existing roads as they are restored.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The BuyBoard bid of Fuquay, Inc. in the amount of \$349,466.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. An additional contingency for road restoration in an amount of \$25,544.00 is hereby approved, bringing the total project to a price not to exceed \$375,000.00.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, is authorized to enter into a construction contract with Fuquay Inc. for the Pipeline Rehabilitation Project.

SECTION 4. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
