Subject: Engineering Services for Huber Road Sewer Main Extension

Date: August 9, 2017

Staff is requesting approval of a professional services agreement with TRC for engineering services for the Huber Sewer Main Extension in the amount of \$198,197. TRC's scope of work includes the design of the sewer main, preparation of construction documents, and bidding administration. It also includes final inspection and record drawing preparation. Please note this project will be funded by the Utility Impact Fee fund.

The project will consist of the installation of approximately 6,500 linear feet of sanitary sewer gravity main along Huber Road extending from the existing 24 inch sewer main on the north side of IH-10 to the north side of Rudeloff Road. The final sewer main size (18 inch or 24 inch) will be determined during the preliminary design phase of the project. The proposed sewer main will provide sewer service to an area between Hwy 46, SH 123, and north of IH-10 where there is currently no service. The proposed improvements will also make the extension of sewer service north of Rudeloff Road more feasible.

Staff recommends approval and will be available to answer any questions at the August 15, 2017 City Council Meeting.
