On April 28, 2014, the City of Seguin was awarded funding through the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), following an October 2013 application to the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) for improvements to Tor Drive. Following the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) process, the City contracted with Brown and Gay Engineering (BGE) to design the road widening project.

On July 25, 2017, eleven (11) bids were received for the Project Base bid and Alternate No. 1 (milling removal and disposal). The bids range as follows:

Base Bid Low	Dean Word Company, Ltd.	\$ 2,569,863.255
High base bid	Denbow Utility Construction, Inc.,	\$ 3,768,591.45
Low Add Alt. #1	Angel Brothers Enterprises, Ltd.,	\$ -6,500.00
High Add Alt. #1	Curran Contracting Company	\$ 19,740.00

An extensive reference check of Dean Word Company, Ltd., has been performed by BGE and we are in receipt of the Texas Department of Transportation concurrence letter. Therefore, staff concurs with the engineer's recommendation to award the Tor Drive Widening Project, CSJ #0915-046-042 to Dean Word Company, Ltd., in the base bid amount of \$2,569,863.255 and add alternate #1 bid of \$100.00 for a total contract price of \$2,569,963.255.

Funding is from the 2013, 2016 and 2017 Certificate of Obligations funds.
