CITY OF SEGUIN

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR A STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE GRANT THAT FUNDS THREE ENTRY-LEVEL FIREFIGHTER POSITIONS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in February 2017, the City applied for a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Grant ("SAFER Grant") from the Department of Homeland Security acting through the Federal Emergency Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, the SAFER Grant is a three-year program that provides 75% of the funding for the salaries of three entry-level firefighters during the first two years and 35% of the funding for the third year; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded \$368,420.00 under the SAFER Grant with a required City match of \$229,023.00 over a three year period beginning at the end of February 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City's match for FY 2018 will be \$38,975.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby accepts the SAFER Grant awarded by FEMA and reaffirms that the City will abide by the Grant's terms and conditions as set forth in the application therefor.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is effect beginning February 25, 2018.
