A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DANNENBAUM ENGINEERING COMPANY – AUSTIN, LLC, FOR A FEMA FLOODPLAIN STUDY AND SUBMISSION OF A LETTER OF MAP REVISION FOR LITTLE MILL CREEK BETWEEN RUDELOFF ROAD AND THE NEWQUEST PROPERTY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City has received a number of development inquiries along the SH 46 corridor in the Little Mill Creek drainage basin; and

WHEREAS, as part of the MPO road reconstruction project the City will need to commission a floodplain study of a section of Little Mill Creek at Rudeloff Road; and

WHEREAS, Dannenbaum Engineering – Austin, LLC (“Dannenbaum”) performed a flood plain analysis on part of Little Mill Creek for the NewQuest Property; and

WHEREAS, the attached professional services agreement proposed by Dannenbaum, in the sum of \$65,800.00, will cover the floodplain study and the submission of a Letter of Map Revision to Fema for the studied area; and

WHEREAS, City staff is also proposing a development fee to recoup some of the costs from the future developers who will benefit from this study.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby approves a Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$65,800.00 submitted by Dannenbaum for a floodplain study and submission of a LOMR for the Little Mill Creek.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a professional services agreement with Dannenbaum.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
