A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR A COMMUNITY POLICING DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUBMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice has solicited applications for the Community Policing Development Program; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this program is to develop the law enforcement capacity to work closer with the community to develop better strategies for preventing crime and promoting safe communities; and

WHEREAS, the Seguin Police Department is seeking two years of funding to create an opioid detection, eradication and community education unit; and

WHEREAS, the grant request is in the amount of \$300,000.00, split between each of the two years, with no required matching funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, to submit a grant application to U.S. Department of Justice Community Policing Development Program.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in the grant program.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
