**Subject:** 2018 Local Border Security Program

The Homeland Security Grants Division of the Governor's Office has solicited applications for projects that support Operation Border Star during the 2018 grant cycle. The purpose of the program is to sustain interagency law enforcement operations and enhance local law enforcement patrols in an effort to deter and facilitate directed actions to interdict criminal activity. The Texas General Appropriations Act authorizes these state funds.

A grant application was submitted before the March 30, 2018 deadline for the Seguin Police Department requesting continued funding to allow the deployment of additional manpower to intercept the trafficking of drugs and weapons along Interstate 10 as well as State Highways 123 and 46. The City was awarded \$15,000 for this purpose during the 2018 grant cycle, which ends August 31, 2018.

If awarded, the requested funds for \$21,152.88 will cover overtime costs associated with this project. This amount is based on the overtime rate and of three police officers working 42 hours per month. No matching funds are required.

Staff requests approval of a revised resolution be passed as to comply to the Office of the Governor's requirements.
