ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 98, TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE II, TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, SECTION 98-43 TRUCK ROUTES, TO CLARIFY LANGUAGE AND ADD FM HIGHWAYS; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO SUBMIT THIS ORDINANCE AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, in reviewing the truck route ordinance, prior to the final installation of signs, city staff noticed that FM highways were left out and that certain other clarifications were necessary; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance make the needed changes to the Truck Routes to be consistent with the plan that is being put into place.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION ONE. The Seguin Code of Ordinances, Chapter 98, Traffic and Vehicles, Article II, Traffic Control Devices, Section 98-43(a), Truck Routes, is amended as follows (underlining indicates added text, ~~strikethrough~~ indicates deleted text), with all other subsections remaining unchanged:

(a) Unless otherwise ~~shown~~ accepted in the following ~~maps diagrams~~, all interstate highway, ~~and~~ state highway numbered routes, and FM numbered routes within the city are designated as truck routes with exception- except for the following: U.S. Highway 90 Alternate (Court Street) between State Highway 46 and State Highway 123 Bypass; and State Highway 123 Business (Austin Street) between U.S. Hwy 90 (Kingsbury St) and State Highway 46S; and FM466 (King St/Eastwood Dr) between U.S. 90 and State Hwy 123 Bypass; FM 725 between Hwy 46S and State Hwy 123 Business (Stockdale Hwy); and FM 467 between State Hwy 46S and State Highway 123 Business (Stockdale Hwy). ~~within the city are designated as truck routes.~~

SECTION TWO. If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions of this Ordinance will continue in force if they can be given effect without the invalid portion.

SECTION THREE. City staff is authorized to prepare this Ordinance for submission as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.

SECTION FOUR. This Ordinance shall become effective ten days from passage on second reading
