**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS LIMITING COLLECTION  
ACCEPTED ON CLEAN-UP DAYS TO TWO BOXES FOR SHREDDING AND TEN TIRES  
FOR DISPOSAL PER RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE**

**WHEREAS**, twice a year the City sponsors a clean-up day that is mainly designed to help rid the City of unsightly trash and assist residents in disposing of unwanted bulky items; and

**WHEREAS**, clean-up day was not designed for use by businesses and it has been the policy of the City to not accept tires, construction debris and other commercial materials; and

**WHEREAS**, in the last clean-up day problems arose from the disposal of commercial quantities of tires and paper to be shredded; and

**WHEREAS**, in these circumstances the available truck was filled earlier in the day thereby denying residents of the ability to dispose of their trash; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff has examined the problem and recommends that paper to be shredded be limited to two (2) boxes (or trash bags) per car, and tires limited to 10 tires per car; and

**WHEREAS**, these limitations are consistent with the maximum disposal needs of a residential dwelling.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

**PART ONE.** The City Council of Seguin, Texas hereby reaffirms the policy that the Clean-Up days were designed for residential purposes.

**PART TWO.** The disposal of tires will be limited to ten (10) tires per car or family.

**PART THREE.** The disposal of paper for shredding will be limited to two boxes or two trash bags per car or family.

**PART FOUR.** This Resolution is in effect from and after the date of its passage.
