Re: Resolution Authorizing Eminent Domain Proceedings to Acquire Rights in Specific

Tracts, Schertz/Seguin Local Government Corporation Secondary Pipeline Project

On March 20, 2018, the City of Seguin City Council approved Resolution No. 2018R-038 authorizing the negotiation and purchase including the use of eminent domain proceedings for the acquisition of permanent and temporary construction easements in connection with a water pipeline to be constructed parallel to the existing pipeline owned and operated by the Schertz/Seguin Local Government Corporation.

SSLGC, through its agents, has made good faith offers based on an independent fee appraisal. Negotiations ensued but were unsuccessful. Easements are necessary for the project and given the futility of further negotiations, condemnation is recommended.

This resolution authorizes eminent domain proceedings to acquire rights in the following tracts for the Schertz/Seguin Local Government Corporation Secondary Pipeline Project:
