Update on Business 123 (Austin Street) Reconstruction Project and other projects - Will Lockett, TxDOT Area Engineer

TxDOT Area Engineer Will Lockett provided an overall progress report on North Austin Street. The underground and utility adjustments have been completed. Contractor is working on forming junction boxes and get them installed. The goal is to make Austin Street a two-way street again. At this time, no date scheduled.

Council Member Lievens inquired about the manpower on the project - Mr. Lockett said he drove by Monday and Wednesday of last week and there were 13 one day and 17 the next.

IH-10 Frontage Road - First TxDOT looked to build overhead signage, however it has been decided to go with placard signs on the roadways.

Truck Route Sign installation should be completed by November/December timeline.

After discussion it was the consensus of the City Council that they are concerned about the businesses along North Austin Street and encourage TxDOT to complete the job ASAP.
