City Engineer Joe Ramos presented a Street Improvement Planning update touching on the importance of "good drainage is absolutely essential for satisfactory pavement performance and long-term trouble free. Some of the considerations on street selections includes: 1) Distribute around town, 2) Types of Treatment could be crack seal, chip seal, HA5, reclaim, reclaim and overlay, overlay rehab, reconstruction. 3) Utility conflicts or scheduled utility projects are taken into great consideration. John Donnelly, Streets Manager enters into the data base each time work is completed on a street, whether it is partial or the entire street.
