Subject: **Approval of an Amended Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the City of Seguin and the City of New Braunfels setting the boundary of the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) between the two cities.**

Date: November 28, 2018

On November 20, 2018 the Seguin City Council approved an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the City of Seguin and the City of New Braunfels to exchange certain areas along a common ETJ boundary between the two cities. The New Braunfels City Council considered approval of the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement at a regular council meeting on November 26, 2018. Following public comment received from residents in the affected areas, the New Braunfels City Council approved an amended version of the agreement in which the properties in the River Springs and Three Oaks subdivisions were removed from the agreement to remain in the existing New Braunfels ETJ.

Seguin city staff has updated the agreement and the map to reflect the amended version of the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement approved by the New Braunfels City Council. Seguin city staff recommends approval of the amended agreement as attached.
