## STATE OF TEXAS

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY THAT IS OBSOLETE, DYSFUNCTIONAL OR TOO COSTLY TO REPAIR; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, from time to time various items of property owned by the City become obsolete, dysfunctional or in need costly repairs that render the item unusable; and

**WHEREAS**, City policy dictates that the City Council approve the sale of items with a cost of \$5,000.00 or more; and

WHEREAS, a 2007 and 2012 Vermeer Brush Chippers are no longer useable by the City; and

WHEREAS, Vermeer Equipment of Texas, Inc. has offered to purchase said equipment for \$11,000 and \$13,000 respectively; and

**WHEREAS**, based on research of recent auction prices, the City cannot reasonably expect to obtain a higher price through an auction process for this equipment; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends that these items be sold to Vermeer Equipment of Texas, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby declares that the 2007 and 2012 Vermeer Brush Chippers are surplus and of no net economic benefit to the City.

**SECTION 2.** City staff is directed to sell the items to Vermeer Equipment of Texas, Inc. for a total of \$24,000.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
