A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY THAT IS OBSOLETE, DYSFUNCTIONAL OR TOO COSTLY TO REPAIR; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, from time to time various items of property owned by the City become obsolete, dysfunctional or in need of costly repairs that render the item unusable; and

WHEREAS, City policy dictates that the City Council approve the sale of items with a cost of \$5,000.00 or more; and

WHEREAS, Unit 2418, a 2007 Ford F750 brush truck is no longer useable by the City; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends that this item be placed on GovDeals.com to be sold to the highest bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby declares that Unit 2418, the 2007 Ford F750 brush truck is surplus and of no net economic benefit to the City.

SECTION 2. City staff is directed to list the item for sale on GovDeals.com to be sold to the highest bidder.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
