**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS  
APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE  
GOVERNOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FOR A JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT TO  
PURCHASE TEN IN-CAR LAPTOPS FOR USE BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT;  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED  
WITH THE SUBMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS** the Police Department needs to upgrade the laptop computers that they use in their vehicles;  
and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Governor, through its Justice Assistance Grant, provides funds to assist local  
law enforcement with its services that are consistent with the Criminal Justice Division; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department is seeking to purchase ten in-car laptops for newly acquired vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, matching funds are not required for this grant; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff requests approval for the submission of the grant application.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, to  
submit a grant application to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division for a Justice  
Assistance Grant to be used to fund the purchase of ten in-car laptops.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive  
Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in  
the grant program.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
