**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS
AWARDING A BID WITH ADDITIVE ALTERNATES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
557,227.00 TO R.P. CONSTRUCTORS, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE
INFRASTRUCTURE FOR THE BACKUP ELECTRIC GENERATOR; AND DECLARING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, as part of the provision of a constant water supply to the City's customers Council has approved projects to provide backup electric power to the water treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, two companies submitted responses to the City's request for proposals, that included additive alternates, for the construction of a raised steel platform, control panel and installation of the generator being supplied by the City; and

WHEREAS, the two bids ranged from a low base bid of \$495,027 from R.P. Constructors, Inc. to a high base bid of \$671,927.00 from MGC Contractors, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, city staff long with Craig Bell of TRC reviewed the two bids, along with the additive alternates, as well as the experience and references for each of the two bidders; and

WHEREAS, based on references, experience with similar projects staff and the City's consultant recommend awarding the bid, along with the additive alternates and contingency of \$22,200.00, in the total amount not to exceed \$557,027.00 to the low bidder, R.P. Constructors, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The bid, plus add alternates, for electrical infrastructure improvements to the City's water treatment plant, in the amount of \$557,027.00 awarded to R.P. Constructors, Inc.

SECTION 2. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
