A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDING A BID WITH ADDITIVE ALTERNATES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED 557,227.00 TO R.P. CONSTRUCTORS, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR THE BACKUP ELECTRIC GENERATOR; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, as part of the provision of a constant water supply to the City's customers Council has approved projects to provide backup electric power to the water treatment plant; and

**WHEREAS**, two companies submitted responses to the City's request for proposals, that included additive alternates, for the construction of a raised steel platform, control panel and installation of the generator being supplied by the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the two bids ranged from a low base bid of \$495,027 from R.P. Constructors, Inc. to a high base bid of \$671,927.00 from MGC Contractors, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff long with Craig Bell of TRC reviewed the two bids, along with the additive alternates, as well as the experience and references for each of the two bidders; and

WHEREAS, based on references, experience with similar projects staff and the City's consultant recommend awarding the bid, along with the additive alternates and contingency of \$22,200.00, in the total amount not to exceed \$557,027.00 to the low bidder, R.P. Constructors, Inc.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The bid, plus add alternates, for electrical infrastructure improvements to the City's water treatment plant, in the amount of \$557,027.00 awarded to R.P. Constructors, Inc.

**SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
