AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS CREATING A NO PARKING ZONE ON BOTH SIDES OF EIGHTH STREET IN THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City has received numerous complaints about on street parking by heavy trucks including litter and other associated problems, along Eighth Street from the railroad tracks to Rio Nogales Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that Eighth Street was designed for heavy truck traffic serving the local businesses and not for parking and the litter deposited by the persons operating the parked trucks is a blight; and

WHEREAS, parked traffic also impedes ingress and egress to the properties along Eighth Street.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council adopts the findings of the City Engineer and restricts parking along Eighth Street as follows:

A no parking zone is established on both sides of Eighth Street from the Union Pacific Railroad tracks to Rio Nogales Drive.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby directs the public works director to erect the appropriate signs in the areas indicated in Section 1.

SECTION 3. The changes in parking made by this Ordinance shall be effective on and after the day the appropriate signs are erected.
