A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE FOR HURRICANE HARVEY INFRASTRUCTURE REPLACEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMETNS ASSOCIATED WITH THE GRANT SUBMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Texas General Land Office (the "GLO") has announced a grant program to support recovery from the effects on municipal infrastructure caused by Hurricane Harvey; and

WHEREAS, during the hurricane one of the City's firetrucks was destroyed costing the city \$617,180.00 for a replacement; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends submitting an application to the GLO for a grant in the amount of \$234,000.00 that, if awarded, would be used to partially fund the tax notes that were issued for the firetruck replacement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the submittal of a grant application to the Texas General Land Office for Hurricane Harvey Infrastructure replacement.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all documents related to the grant application.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
