A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDING A BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,171,810.00 TO CAPITAL EXCAVATION FOR THE NORTH KING STREET ROADWAY, DRAINAGE AND UTILITY PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH CAPITAL EXCAVATION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Plan, the City issued a Request for Proposals for the North King Street Roadway, Drainage, and Utility Improvements Project (the "King Street Project"); and

WHEREAS, five sealed bids were received for the King Street Project ranging from a low of \$2,876,836.00 submitted by D&S Concrete Contractors to a high of \$4,395,563.50 submitted by JR Sitework, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the low bidder, D&S Concrete Contractors did not meet the criteria for experience with the size and scope of the King Street Project; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing references and other experience staff and its consultant, Luis Cuellar of RPS Group, recommend awarding the King Street Project to the second low bidder Capital Excavation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the bid of the second low bidder, Capital Excavation in the amount of \$\$3,171,810.00 for the North King Street Roadway, Drainage and Utility Project.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, is authorized to enter into a construction contract with Capital Excavation for the Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
