A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR CRIME VICTIM SERVICES DIVISION FOR THE 2020-2021 VICTIM COORDINATOR AND LIAISON GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUBMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS the City is required to have a staff position as a Crime Victim's Liaison; and

WHEREAS, this position is funded by grants issued through the Office of Attorney General- Crime Victim Services Division; and

WHEREAS, the City of requesting a grant in the amount of \$84,000 to cover two years salary for this position; and

WHEREAS, the City's match for the grant consists of the cost of all benefits and any salary above the amount granted; and

WHEREAS, city staff requests approval for the submission of the grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Seguin authorizes City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, to submit a grant application to the Office of the Governor – Crime Victim Services Division for a grant to cover the salary for a Crime Victim Liaison.

SECTION 2. The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the City's participation in the grant program.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
