Subject: Award of Bid – King Street Roadway, Drainage, and Utility Improvements

Date: April 10, 2019

On March 12, 2019 the City of Seguin opened bids for the King Street Roadway, Drainage, and Utility Improvements Project. The project will consist of the installation of street, drainage, and utility improvements on King Street from Pine Street to the Union Pacific Railroad.

Five sealed bids were received for the project, which ranged from \$2,876,836.00, from D&S Concrete Contractors to \$4,395,563.50, from JR Sitework, Inc. Luis Cuellar, Vice President from RPS Infrastructure, Inc., our consulting engineer, and city staff have reviewed the proposed bids and recommend awarding the contract to Capital Excavation based on positive references, experience with similar projects, and being the lowest qualified bidder. D&S Concrete Contractors' project experience did not meet the criteria for the size and scope of the project.

Please find attached Recommendation of Award of Contract Letter from RPS, dated April 5, 2019, recommending that Capital Excavation be awarded the construction project in the amount of \$3,171,810.00. Staff concurs with this recommendation and will be available to answer any questions at the Tuesday, April 16, 2019, City Council Meeting.
