\$ 12,000	Utility Fund Water/Wastewater Maintenance Chemicals 002-5700-613300	Utility Fund Non-Departmental Use of Retained Earnings 002-9800-960000	
Reason requested:	To appropriate additional funding towards chemicals for the Gateshead Lift Station. These additional chemicals are needed to bind excessive hydrogen sulfide in solution whereas it does not become hydrogen sulfide gas. Hydrogen sulfide gas in high concentration is a dangerous sewer gas that poses significant hazards to wastewater maintenance staff. In addition, at lower concentration it produces a noxious odor that has been present in the Sagebiel Road area of the City's collection system. This has led to multiple customer complaints and ultimately the installation of this chemical injection system.

Reason requested:	To appropriate funds towards engineering for the North Substation. Staff has been working with LCRA and Schneider Engineering over the past three years planning for this substation. It was originally scheduled for the FY20 budget year, but has been moved up to potentially come online in November of this year.

Reason requested:	To appropriate funds towards the finished water blending system. Currently, the Water Plant is designed to allow blending of surface water with ground water, however, the design does not offer staff quantitative control over the blending ratios. The control is necessary as the ratio of surface to ground water will impact water chemistry. Blending control is necessary to maintain the chemistry of the finished water so there is no change in taste or odor as well as hardness or alkalinity. The need for this project is driven by NBU taking water beginning in April 2019.

We have budgeted a total of \$40,000 in General Fund and \$40,000 in Utility Fund. We have used all those funds and more employees are requesting to move into the city limits.
