Subject: City of Seguin – Water Conservation Plan

Date: May 29, 2019

The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) requires retail public water suppliers with more than 3,300 connections to:

- Conduct and submit a water loss audit annually;
- Report annually to the TWDB on the progress in implementing their current water conservation plan;
- Develop and submit an updated water conservation plan to the TWDB every five years

The changes to the Seguin Water Conservation Plan include updated water treatment processes, water storage and capacity information, details related to permitted water, and alternate water supply information. The plan also includes updated reuse water data for industrial users.

Staff recommends approval of the amended 2019 Seguin Water Conservation Plan and will be available to answer any questions at the Tuesday, June 4, 2019 City Council Meeting.
