The Seguin Police Department respectfully requests to be considered for a narcotics analyst position supported by the Texas National Guard Counterdrug program. We currently have an authorized strength of three (3) narcotics officers who carry a significant workload within the City of Seguin. One of these Detectives is assigned to the DEA Task Force in San Antonio. We would request this to be a year long mission in order to assist our counterdrug efforts.

The analytic support staff would be utilized to further our ongoing narcotics investigative efforts both locally within the City of Seguin as well as our interdiction efforts along IH-10.
