The City Council and Parks Board participated in a visioning exercise. Discussed what each felt was their vision, some topics included 1) a recreational center with an olympic size pool, 2) senior component in each park, 3) restrooms are needed downtown, 4) baseball facilities need to be upgraded, 5) more amenities in each park, 6) identify different locations for parks in existing neighborhoods, 7) what makes Seguin different, what attracts people, 8) Starcke Park East river is unaccessible for large public usage.
