A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDED A BID WITH ADDITIVE ALTERNATE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$749,408.22 TO BELL CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A SANITARY SEWER FORCE MAIN AND PARALLEL LINE SERVING THE GERONIMO CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2019, the force main serving the Geronimo Creek Wastewater treatment plant experienced a significant leak; and

WHEREAS, during the repair process staff determined that the pipe needed to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, TRC, the City's design engineer for the upgrade to the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant has recommended a second, parallel line serving the plant as part of the future upgrade; and

WHEREAS, constructing both lines at the same time would save the city approximately 277,704.00; and

WHEREAS, staff received sealed bids for the two lines from three contractors who have worked with the City ranging from a low base bid of \$556,606.91 from Bell Contractors, Inc. to a high bid of \$1,135,293.00 from RP Constructors, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, based on experience with similar projects and bid amount city staff recommends a contract with Bell Contractors, Inc. to include the additive alternate in the amount of \$120,801.31 and \$72,000.00 in contingency for a not to exceed sum of \$749,408.22.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The bid, plus additive alternate and contingency, for the construction of parallel force mains serving the Geronimo Creek Wastewater Treatment plant in the amount of \$749,408.22 is awarded to Bell Contractors, Inc.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Bell Contractors, Inc. for the parallel force main construction as outlined in this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
