## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL GRANT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE GRANT SUBMISSION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Department of Transportation is currently seeking applications for the Safe Routes to School Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, city staff proposes to seek funds to construct approximately 1700 linear feet of sidewalk on North Heideke Street between East Seidemann and East Kingsbury and North Bruns Street between Pine and East Weinert Street; and

WHEREAS, the proposed sidewalk routes would serve Weinert Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the grant application seeks \$685,351.00 with no match required; and

**WHEREAS**, if awarded the City would, however, need to pay for certain initial costs in the amount of \$62,229.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby approves the submittal of a grant application to the Texas Department of Transportation for a grant application from the Safe Routes to School Program.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute all documents related to the grant application.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
