## **STATE OF TEXAS**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDING A BID IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$236,679.73 TO C-3 ENVIRONMENTAL SPECIALTIES FOR INSTALLATION OF DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE CHAPARRAL DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; UTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH C-3 ENVIRONMENTAL SPECIALTIES; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City posted an RFP for drainage improvements needed in the Chaparral Subdivision area; and

**WHEREAS**, five companies submitted responses to the City's request for proposals for the construction of specified drainage improvements; and

WHEREAS, the five bids ranged from a low base bid of \$236,679.73 from C-3 Environmental Specialists to a high base bid of \$404,167.25 from Shannon-Monk; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff long with Beau Perry of TRC reviewed the five bids as well as the experience and references for each of the five bidders; and

WHEREAS, based on references, experience with similar projects staff and the City's consultant recommend awarding the bid in an amount not to exceed \$236,679.73 to the low bidder, C-3 Environmental Specialties.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

**SECTION 1.** The bid for drainage improvements in the Chaparral Subdivision in the amount of \$236,679.73 is awarded to C-3 Environmental Specialties.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager, Douglas G. Faseler, is authorized to enter into a construction contract for \$236,679.73 with C-3 Environmental Specialties for the drainage improvement project.

**SECTION 3.** This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
