Next year's paving schedule is projected to be aggressive with the following streets proposed for zipper improvements (totaling approximately 31,000 LF of roadway).

PUBLIC WORKS

As previously stated, P2 Emulsion provides easy and safe soil stabilization without the use of additional aggregate or other stabilizers, such as lime, soil, cement or acid additives; prolonging the integrity of the street and extending its life maintenance. This stabilizer can only be purchased from P2 Emulsion, a sole source provider.

Therefore, staff requests to continue the sole source purchase of P2 Emulsion for street improvements for fiscal year 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$300,000. The award will allow staff to proceed with purchase effective October 1, 2019 (new fiscal year) thus, avoiding any downtime, weather permitting, by crews to begin on the proposed improvements.
