A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS AWARDING A BID IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,084,650.00 TO THE KOEHLER COMPANY FOR GOLF PRO SHOP REHABILITATION PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE KOEHLER COMPANY; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the city solicited bids for the rehabilitation of the Golf Pro Shop at the Max Starcke Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, six bids were received ranging from a low base bid of \$1,077,900.00 from R.L. Rhode General Contracting to a high base bid of \$1,415,200.00 from Sullivan Contracting Services.; and

WHEREAS, city staff along with Tim Gescheidle, the city's architect for the project, reviewed the six bids as well as the experience and references for each of the six bidders; and

WHEREAS, based on references, experience with similar projects staff and the City's consultant recommend awarding the bid in an amount not to exceed \$1,084,650 to the second low bidder, The Koehler Company.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The bid for the rehabilitation of the Golf Pro Shop in the amount of \$1,084,650.00 is awarded to The Koehler Company.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized to enter into a construction contract for \$1,084,650.00 with The Koehler Company for the Golf Pro Shop Rehabilitation Project.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on the date of its passing.
