Subject:	Submittal of FY21 Justice Assistance Grant Program

The Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division is soliciting grant applications for the FY21 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG).

The Police Department will be submitting a grant application in response to this solicitation. The grant application is for the purchase of ten WatchGuard mobile video recording systems for in-car video recording. The grant project title is <u>FY21 WatchGuard Technology Upgrade</u>. The amount of the grant application is \$97,930.00 and there is no match requirement for this grant.

The grant application requires an approved resolution from the City Council that contains the following:

- 1. Authorization for the submission of the application to the Public Safety Office (PSO) that clearly defines the name of the project for which funding is requested;
- 2. A commitment to provide all applicable matching funds;
- 3. A designation of the name and/or title of the Authorized Official who is given the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate a grant; and
- 4. A written assurance that, in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the governing body will return all funds to the POS.

Staff requests approval of the resolution to submit with the grant application.
