**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING
SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN RESPONSE TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR,
PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FUNDING ANNOUNCEMENT CRIMINAL
JUSTICE PROGRAM, FY2021**

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin Police Department must upgrade their mobile video recording systems as the current Data 911 recording system has reached end-of-life; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin Police Department wishes to upgrade to WatchGuard mobile video recording systems, an industry standard that provides all requested system features: and

WHEREAS, the City is submitting a grant application entitled FY21 WatchGuard Technology Upgrade for \$97,930 with no required matching funds in response to this grant solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin has authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City of Seguin authorizes the submission of an application entitled FY21 WatchGuard Technology Upgrade to the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division.

SECTION 2: The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Official to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Grant Program.

SECTION 3: Expenditures of the grant shall be administered in compliance with the Criminal Justice Division guidelines, terms and conditions of the grant award including all matching funds, if applicable. The City Manager will assure that the grant funds are expended in accordance with grant guidelines. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City of Seguin will return all funds to the Public Safety Office.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
