Presentation and discussion on a draft of the Parks, Recreation, Open Space, and Trails Master Plan - Jack Jones, Director of Parks and Recreation

Mark Maldonado, Project Manager with Stantec presented a draft of the 10-year master parks plan to assist the City of Seguin in current and future parks, recreational, open spaces and trail opportunities. According to Texas Parks and Wildlife plans must be updated every five years. The plan was broken down into five focus categories.

- 1. Acquisition of more land for the creation of new parks.
- 2. Improvements to existing Parks and Recreational Facilities
- 3. Expand and create additional Recreational Programming
- 4. Develop a Recreational Center Facility/Indoor-Outdoor Aquatics
- 5. Develop additional Trails and Trail Connections

Top Priority Needs identified from the public input were:

- 1. Provide General Renovations to Existing Park
- 2. Complete a Recreation Center Facility/Indoor-Outdoor Aquatics Feasibility Study
- 3. Develop Existing Parkland/New Parks
- 4. Develop Additional Trails and Trail Connections
- 5. Increase Shade Structures at Playgrounds
- 6. Improve River Access
- 7. Expand and create additional Recreational Programming and Special Events
- 8. Conduct Max Starcke Park Renovations and Improvements
- 9. Establish New Parks in Underserviced Areas

Community surveys brought in over 1900 responses. Mayor Keil said achieving the goals presented by the plan will require the cooperation of the community. Council was concerned about closing River Road in Starcke Park West with the location of the river and the golf course.

The adoption of the Parks, Recreation, Open Spaces and Trails Master Plan will be presented to City Council in March 2020.
