The Police Department has surplus equipment that is intended to be disposed of which may be repurposed for two other law enforcement agencies. Caldwell County Constables Office contacted our department and requested any Ford Crown Victoria police equipment no longer in use as well as any body armor not in use. The Police Department no longer utilizes Crown Victoria sedans therefore this equipment surplus. We also rotate our body armor every five years as suggested by the manufacturer. One set of body armor currently in use by the Caldwell County Constables office was purchased in 1994.

We would like to donate eighteen sets of body armor and assorted Crown Victoria Sedan police equipment with an approximate original cost of \$13,855.00. An itemized list and Disposal Asset Form are attached.

The Police Department would also like to donate three FreeLinc mobile radio interfaces to the Nixon Police Department. These devices are not utilized by our Department nor will they be in the future. The original cost was approximately \$400.00.
