Discussion and approval to cancel the July 4th parade in Seguin, Texas - Mayor Don Keil

Mayor Don Keil said that it was with great disappointment that the City of Seguin must cancel all the July 4th festivities for 2020 due to the rapid peak in COVID-19 cases in Seguin and Guadalupe County. City Manager Steve Parker provided the latest stats.

Council Member Jet Crabb said that she received a telephone call from a physician that stated he personally has given three individuals a report of positive for COVID-19; however he has seen them out in the public with no mask, no precautions. This is a total disregard of safety for yourself and your fellow mankind. Ms. Crabb made an appeal to all citizens to take this pandemic seriously, follow the CDC guidelines.
