A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A ONE YEAR FACILITIES USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN SEGUIN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS FOR USE OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN SMOKEY JOE WILLIAMS BASEBALL FIELD, THE PECAN BOTTOM IN THE EAST SIDE OF MAX STARCKE PARK, THE MAX STARCKE PARK GOLF COURSE, AND THE PARK WEST CONCESSION BUILDING AND LARGE PAVILION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin and the Seguin Independent School District (hereinafter called the District), believe that use of certain city park facilities to include: the Smokey Joe Williams Baseball Field by the District's baseball program; the pecan bottom in the east side of Max Starcke Park for cross-country track meets; and Max Starcke Golf Course for team golf practice, and the Park West Concession Building and Large Pavilion for the summer meal program is a wise use that benefits both the citizens of Seguin, Texas and the students of the District; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin hereby agrees to cooperatively provide the use of the park facilities at which the District will conduct their programs in return for the fees set forth in the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Seguin:

- 1. The attached Agreement between City of Seguin and the District is hereby approved.
- 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the attached Agreement on behalf of the City of Seguin.
