CITY OF SEGUIN

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT - MITIGATION PROJECT APPLICATION TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT & REVITALIZATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Seguin, Texas desires to develop a thriving, viable, community, strengthen infrastructure, provide a suitable living environment, and expand economic opportunities, principally for person of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of City to apply for funding under the Community Development Block Grant Mitigation Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That a Community Development Block Grant Program application is hereby authorized to be filed with the Texas General Land Office for funding consideration under the Community Development Block Grant - Mitigation Program; and

SECTION 2: That the application be for the CDBG-MIT Program through the Competition or Method of Distribution Application program to carry out Infrastructure Activities; and

SECTION 3: That the grant amount be up to the maximum allowed by the CDBG-MIT program and may include a minimum one percent (1%) match; and

SECTION 4. That the City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and participation in the Community Development & Revitalization Grant Program.
