RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, TO ADOPT THE ALAMO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN EFFECTIVE FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2021

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the City to demonstrate our commitment to implementing actions that eliminate or reduce the severity of natural hazards for our people and property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin, Texas was a Participant in the approved Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG) Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the AACOG Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan expired on July 12, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the AACOG Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan should be adopted until such time a new Hazard Mitigation Plan is presented to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the involved parties are working on a new Hazard Mitigation Plan that will be ready for adoption by December 31, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City Council authorizes the adoption of the AACOG Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan until December 31, 2021.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
