Presentation and Public Hearing on Updates to the Land Use Assumptions, Capital Improvement Plans, and Water and Wastewater Impact Fees - David Rabago, City Engineer, P.E., CFM

Indexes:

David Rabago, City Engineer gave a presentation on the Land Use Assumptions, Capital Improvement Plans, and Water and Wastewater Impact Fee. Mr. Rabago gave a brief description of when Impact Fees are charged to customers and that the fees collected are used to pay a portion of the costs necessary to provide services for new development, which may include installation of new transmission lines or the upgrades of existing lines. Fees can also be utilized for the upgrade/installation of pumps, storage tanks, and treatment plants. Impact fees help reduce the burden on existing utility customers' utility rates when new growth and development generate the need for system wide improvements and/or expansions. State laws require that cities conduct an update to their Impact Fee Study every five years and regulate the process in which the update conducted. City staff, in conjunction with TRC Engineers and Willdan Financial, recently completed an update to the water and wastewater impact fees. The updates include future population growth and land use projections within the service areas. These projections combined with the capital improvement plans are used to calculate the maximum impact fees the City can charge to tie into the City's water and wastewater systems. Utilities typically establish a maximum impact fee and an effective fee. Maximum fees are the maximum amount a Utility can charge for tying into the system. Effective fees are typically set below the maximum amount to provide some relief to new home buyers.
