8	trust, or association may not establish or operate a cemetery, or
9	use any land for the interment of remains, located:
10	SECTION 2. Section 711.008 (1), Health and Safety Code, is
11	amended to read as follows:

12 (1) Not later than December 1, 2022, an individual, corporation, partnership, firm, trust, or association may file 13 a written application with the governing body of a municipality 14 15 that has a population of at least 75,000 and not more than 100,000 and 16 that is located in a county with a population of at least 140,000 and 17 not more than 180,000, to establish or use a cemetery located within the legal boundaries of the municipality. The municipality by 18 ordinance shall prescribe the information to be included in the 19 20 application. The governing body by ordinance may authorize the 21 establishment or use of the cemetery if the municipality determines 22 and states in the ordinance that the establishment or use of the cemetery does not adversely affect public health, safety, and welfare. 23 24 This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
