RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEGUIN, TEXAS ACCEPTING A DONATION OF PUBLIC ART FOR A STATUE OF AN EAGLE TO BE CARVED IN STARCKE PARK AND APPROVING A CONTRACT FOR THE DONATION AND INSTALLATION OF THE ARTWORK

WHEREAS, the Parks Master Plan recognizes the desirability and need for public art installations; and

WHEREAS, Nathan Beversdorf working with Burr Rasmussen wanted to carve a sculpture in a large stump that exists near the Patricia Irvine Pavilion in Max Starcke Park donating it to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Commission on the Arts considered their request along with several examples of the suggested sculptures; and

WHEREAS, the Commission on the Arts considered the designs, the setting and requirements for future maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Commission on the Arts recommended that, if approved by the Parks Advisory Board and the City Council, the artist move forward with the rendering of an eagle; and

WHEREAS, the donation of the artwork as a rendering of an eagle was also approved by the Parks Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has final approval of all public art pieces.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seguin, Texas:

Part 1. The City Council hereby approves the donation of a statute of an Eagle to be carved by Nathan Beversdorf and Burr Rasmussen in Max Starcke Park.

Part 2. The city manager is hereby authorized to execute the attached agreement with the artists for the carving of the statute, maintenance of the statute and the allocation of rights thereto.
