Subject: Manhole Rehabilitation

Date: March 18, 2021

There are eleven manholes in need of rehabilitation due to corrosion. Three of the eleven manholes have inflow / infiltration and will be repaired as part of this rehabilitation project. This infrastructure serves a residential area commonly referred to as Oak Village North. One of the manholes is located outside this neighborhood in the area near Walnut Branch and Saunders Bridge.

The contract amount is \$88,595.00 through the BuyBoard Purchasing Cooperative. However, staff is requesting a contingency of \$10,000.00 to pay for any needed structural improvements that may be identified as the rehabilitation proceeds.

Funding for this project is provided through the 2018 Utility Revenue Bonds. Staff recommends approval of a manhole rehabilitation contract with Fuquay, Inc. for a not to exceed amount of \$98,595.00 and will be available to answer any questions at the Tuesday, April 6, 2021 City Council Meeting.
